Who are Primary Influence Holiday Camps?

The Coaching Team

All our camps will have a senior Sports Camp Coordinator and a fully qualified Sports Coach Supervisor as a minimum. Depending on the number of activities provided and number of children attending additional staff may also be included in the event. All our staff are fully compliant with the safeguarding policies and enhanced DBS background checks.

The Coaching Teams ensure everything runs smoothly in a safe and inclusive environment whilst engaging children in physical activity and providing exceptional coaching and training services that educate and inspire everyone involved.

Camp Schedule

This can be dependent on the School/Community or Club provision please refer to our webpage 'Holiday Camps' for further information www.primaryinfluence.co.uk

Generally, Holiday Camps are:

- Half Day - this schedule can be either 09:00 – 12:00 or 13:00 – 16:00
- Full Day – this schedule is 09:00 – 16:00 each day
- Full Week – this schedule is Monday-Friday 09:00-16:00
- On the final day we do our 'Minilympics' award ceremony that has run all week, certificates will be handed to the winning team and outstanding individuals. We invite parents / carers to come along and support their children – this ceremony taking place 30 minutes before the end of the camp.



Awards

The awards for the 'Minilympics' are as follows;

- Winning Team (overall 'Minilympics' winner)
- Leadership Award (best overall camper)
- Sportsmanship Award
- Super Star Award (best behaved boy and girl)
- Camp Coordinator Award (most helpful)

Registration

Registration is done through our database; all children attending a Holiday Camp will have to confirm their place through this email: info@primaryinfluence.co.uk confirming your child's name, emergency contact and any special requirements such as allergies or SEN.

However, if you have your own registration service through your school or organisation, please ensure you send us a full copy for our records in any case of emergency and for registration purposes.

On-Camp Registration

Once registered our parent information pack will advise you where drop off and pick up points are for your child. Please avoid being late to camp to ensure there are no delays to your child's activities.

Every day our Camp Coordinator will be at the designated sign in point to register your child and confirm who is picking up your child on the day. If your child will be collected early or late please inform the Camp Coordinator in advance.

What to Bring

Food and drink: We ask that you provide a packed lunch for your child as well as snacks for throughout the day. We usually have 2 or 3 short breaks each day as well as lunch. Please provide sufficient drinks for your child. A water bottle is very handy as they can fill up from the drinking fountains throughout the day.

If your school or organisation is planning to run school dinners or lunches, please inform us in advance.

What to wear

Clothing: Please ensure that your child wears clothes that he/she feels most comfortable in, that they can run around in easily and that you don't mind getting dirty!

Cold/Wet Weather (Autumn/Winter): Please ensure your child is suitably dressed for the weather conditions with appropriate, jumpers, coats, trainers and pumps as required.



Sun-protection

Suntan Lotion (Summer): If your child is able to apply their own suntan lotion we suggest you provide this in their bag. If your child is not able to apply the lotion themselves, please ensure you put it on them prior to class. Unfortunately, we are unable to apply the lotion on to the children.

What if a child has a medical condition?

Allergies or requirements: Please let us know by completing our Medical Information Form if your child has any allergies or any other special medical requirements that we should be made aware of. All information given will be treated with the strictest confidence.

What if my child has an accident?

If a child has a minor accident a qualified first aider will be onsite to deal with any requirements and complete an accident report form with a copy being sent to a parent.

If there are any emergency requirements a parent will be called and informed immediately and made aware of the situation.

What happens if I am late picking up?

Please be aware if you are more than 15 minutes late to pick up your child, a small charge will be incurred due to staffing requirements. If you are aware you are going to be more than 15 minutes late please contact the camp leader via details provided in the Parent Information Form.

What happens if my child is misbehaving?

At Primary Influence we have a strict code of conduct that we follow. Any minor incidents will be dealt with by a Primary Influence coach on site. However, if there are any serious or persistent cases you will be contacted and as a worst case scenario your child could be excluded from the session or camp completely.

Early Birds and Extra Activity

Primary Influence offer early drop off and extra activity services an hour before and two hours after. Early drop off is 08:00-09:00 and Extra Activity is 16:00-18:00, these come at an additional charge and are subject to school/club policies and availability.
